

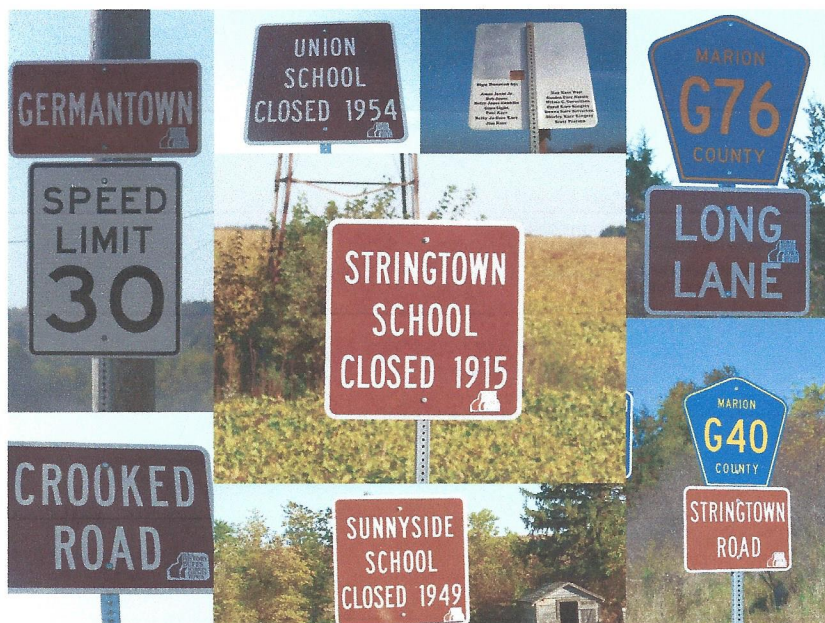
## Marking Rural Historic Sites
